

Linen Stitch Stripes Crochet Blanket

Measurements: Approx 44" x 59" [118 x 150 cm].

SUPPLIES & TOOLS:

Bernat® Forever Fleece™ (9.9 oz/280 g; 194 yds/177 m)

Contrast A Juniper (61007) 4 balls

Contrast B Balsam (61014) 4 balls

Size U.S. M/N 13 [9 mm] crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Yarn needle.

GAUGE: 10.5 sts and 11 rows = 4" [10 cm] in Linen St Pat.

DIRECTIONS:

Stripe Pat

With A, work 12 rows.

**With B, work 2 rows.

With A, work 2 rows.**

Rep from ** to ** twice more.

With B, work 12 rows.

***With A, work 2 rows.

With B, work 2 rows.***

Rep from *** to *** twice more.

These 48 rows form Stripe Pat.

Rep Stripe Pat twice more.

With A, work 12 rows.

156 rows total.

BLANKET

With A, ch 115.

Set up row: (WS). 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. *Ch 1. Skip next ch. 1 sc in next ch. Rep from * to end of chain. Turn. 114 sts.

First row of Stripe Pat is now in position.



Keeping cont of Stripe Pat, proceed as follows:

1st row: (RS). Ch 1. 1 sc in first sc. *1 sc in next ch-1 sp. Ch 1. Skip next sc. Rep from * to last 2 sts. 1 sc in next ch-1 sp. 1 sc in last sc. Turn.

2nd row: Ch 1. 1 sc in first sc. *Ch 1. Skip next sc. 1 sc in next ch-1 sp. Rep from * to last 2 sc. Ch 1. Skip next sc. 1 sc in last sc. Turn.

These 2 rows form Linen St Pat.

Cont in Linen St Pat until all 156 rows of Stripe Pat are complete. Fasten off.

Border:

With RS facing, join B with sl st to any corner sp.

1st rnd: Ch 2 (does not count as st). Work 1 rnd of dc evenly around perimeter of Blanket, working 3 dc into each corner sp. Join with sl st to first dc. Fasten off.
